



2020 BAKED FOOD CONTEST INFORMATION

About the Contest

The Baked Food Contest is hosted by the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Family Fair Committee. In 2020, the contest will take place on Saturday, February 8th.

Age Division

The contestant's division is determined by their age as of August 31, 2019. There are three divisions:

Elementary: 6 - 10 years old Junior: 11 - 13 years old Senior: 14 - 18 years old

Baked Food Classes

Each contestant may have one entry per class. Entries not listed in a class will NOT be accepted. Classification changes are NOT allowed on the day of the contest. Below are the classes:

Contest Entry

- A \$3.00 per class entry fee must be sent in with the entry form
- All entry forms must be mailed and postmarked by Thursday, January 9, 2020
- Each contestant will be mailed one (1) fairgrounds pass and additional instructions after all forms and fees are received

Food Item Presentation

- Cookies, Candy, or Fudge entries must include twelve (12) pieces for judging
- Preferred presentation of food entry is on a disposable plate or thin board no larger than 10" x 14"
- Recommended packaging of food entry is wrapped in clear plastic food wrap
- A copy of the recipe must be taped to the top of the entry
- A 3X5 index card containing the following information must be taped on the bottom of the entry:
 - Name of Baked Food Item & Class Entered
 - Contestant Name
 - Age Division (Elementary, Junior, or Senior)
 - County of Residence
- Food entries not labeled properly will be placed in a class at the discretion of the Family Fair Committee
- San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo, its employees, and volunteers will not be held responsible for any loss or damage

Restrictions

- Each contestant must work alone
- Pre-made mixes are NOT allowed
- On-site preparation is NOT allowed
- Any entry requiring refrigeration is NOT allowed; this includes cream cheese icing
- Any cake presented with a glaze or icing of any kind will be placed in the Iced Cake class

Show Day

- All entries must be checked in between 9:00 AM – 10:00 AM
- Judging will begin at 10:00 AM, winners will be posted thirty minutes after judging is complete
- Baked food entries will be released after winners are posted
- Baked food entries not picked up by 1:00 PM will be disposed of
- Any awards and prizes not picked up by 1:00 PM will be mailed to the winners

Judging and Awards

- Judges' decisions are final
- Awards will be posted between 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM on the day of the contest
- Contestants placing 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Best of Show will be awarded banners, ribbons, or cash prizes
- Best of Show is selected from all first place class winners
- Judges and Family Fair Committee members are the only people allowed in the judging area
