



2020-2021 Rules and Guidelines

In order to fulfill your Calf Scramble program requirements, you must complete the following:

1. SHOW REQUIREMENTS

- a) Enter your Calf Scramble project in the 2021 San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo through your County 4-H or FFA Chapter by December 1, 2020. Individual Club and Chapter deadlines may be earlier. Please enter the Stock Show through the same 4-H Club or FFA Chapter that you entered the Calf Scramble. **Please note, as a calf scramble winner you are not automatically entered in the show.**
- b) Show your project at the 2021 San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo. All projects purchased with the Calf Scramble Certificate MUST be shown. EX: If you purchased two gilts, you are required to show both gilts.

2. CALF SCRAMBLE REPORT SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- a) Complete the Calf Scramble Report System Reports. The information requested on the reports are the minimum requirements of the Calf Scramble Report System.
- b) Calf Scramble Monthly Reports can be found under the Calf Scramble section of <http://www.sarodeo.com/livestock/calf-scramble-report-system>. Monthly Reports will be species specific and will cover various topics such as Animal Selection, Animal Care, Nutrition, etc. Check the Calf Scramble section of our website for further details.
- c) Each Report is due by the 20th of the respective month. The reports must be submitted on sassr.zsuites.org. Each report submitted on or before the respective deadline for that month will be given 5 points added to the overall Final Report Book score. Each report submitted after the respective monthly deadline but on or before the next Monthly Report deadline will receive 2 points added to the Final Report Book score.

3. CALF SCRAMBLE FINAL REPORT BOOK REQUIREMENTS

- a) The Calf Scramble Report System will culminate with a Final Report Book due in the Livestock Office by January 20, 2021. The final report book will be submitted on sassr.zsuites.org.
- b) Judging of the Final Report Book will be based on the following:

30 points	Completeness (All reports complete with in-depth answers)
30 points	Accuracy (Accuracy of answers, monetary figures, & other information)
20 points	Content (Thought provoking answers to reports)
10 points	Overall Appearance & Creativity (Creative pictures, clean graphs, etc.)

- c) Results will be announced by February 1, 2021. Scholarship winners will be presented their certificates at a rodeo performance. Reports received in the Livestock Office after January 20, 2021 will not be judged or considered for competition.

IMPORTANT: If you do not fulfill these requirements, you will not receive the title to your project (Original Registration Papers), may be ineligible to compete with your Calf Scramble Project, and/or may be required to reimburse the San Antonio Livestock Exposition (S.A.L.E.) for the amount of the purchase certificate by March 31, 2021.
